Door supervisor positions

Retail and static positions

To become a part of our team you must be a holder of a valid **SIA approved Security or door supervisor badge**, physically fit, have no criminal record, experience needed but not essential.

You will need to complete a PHILIP SECURITY information form and submit it to us

Preparing for your Interview

If you are invited for an interview at PHILIP SECURITY you need to bring with you:

1. Two proofs of address
2. Your National Insurance number
3. Your SIA badge
4. Dress code: black suit and tie as per work

If you are successful in an interview, an application form must be supplied with all relevant information including two references for us before you may be put into work.

We provide equal opportunity for all our staff to grow with regular performance appraisals.

Company Procedures

1. All door supervisors working for PHILIP SECURITY are class as sole traders (unless you are a static security officer) meaning that they are responsible for there own tax and national insurance. A sole trader account must be opened if you earn over £96.00 per week.
2. Wages are paid a week in hand and start from an hourly rate of £10. Wages are paid directly into your bank account. Details must be included on the application form of your bank details.
3. If you are from another country out of the European Union, you must supply a valid work permit and proof of leave to remain.
